

Spay/Neuter Appointment Information

Congratulations, your kitten(s) has made it to 2 pounds/2 months of age and has been scheduled for their spay/neuter appointment at Orange County Animal Services (OCAS)!

- Your kitty needs to be brought to the OCAS Clinic between 8:00a -8:30a the morning of the scheduled spay/neuter appointment (address is 2769 Conroy Road, Orlando 32839).
- The Clinic receptionist will check you in and give you additional information at that time.
- At check-in please advise the receptionist that you are a Wait 'Til 8 participant and provide your kitty's ID number(s).
- Please let the clinic know if you plan to adopt the kitty, in which case you will pick up the kitty between 3:30p-5:30p the afternoon of their spay/neuter surgery.

Kittens under the age of 6 months are **not** required to fasted the night before their appointment but please give the kitty **only a small snack 2 hours before drop off.**

For the Drop-off location, please refer to the picture below; the Clinic is the 2nd door with the sign "Clinic" above the door (partially hidden in the photo). In this photo there is a car parked in front of the Clinic entrance. The 1st set of double doors leads into the Lobby which will be closed when you drop off for your spay/neuter appointment. If you are adopting your WT8 kitty, the lobby is where you go to fill out adoption paperwork.



If you have decided to adopt your WT8 kitty, you will need to complete the Adoption Application prior to picking up the kitty from Clinic. This may be done the same day as the spay/neuter appointment or prior to that date if you have already received the kitty's ID. The adoption will be finalized after 330p on the day spayed/neutered. When the adoption is finalized you will receive the kitty's medical history, including having been spayed/neutered, vaccinated and tested for feline leukemia/aids. You will also receive the kitty's microchip registration form. Please bring a kitty carrier with you to transport the kitty back to your home; if you do not have one you may ask for a cardboard one to be provided.
