

Spay/Neuter Appointment Information

Congratulations, your kitten(s) has made it to 2 pounds/2 months of age and has been scheduled for their spay/neuter appointment at Orange County Animal Services (OCAS)!

- Your kitty needs to be brought to the OCAS Clinic between 8:00a -8:30a the morning of the scheduled spay/neuter appointment (address is 2769 Conroy Road, Orlando 32839).
- Please bring the kitten(s) in a carrier.
- The Clinic receptionist will check you in and give you additional information at that time.
- At check-in please advise the receptionist that you are a Wait 'Til 8 participant and provide your kitty's ID number(s).
- Please let the clinic staff know that you plan to pick up the kitty; or if someone else is picking up the kitten(s) please let the clinic receptionist know that person's name.
- Pick-up is between 3:30p-5:30p the afternoon of their spay/neuter surgery. Please have the kitten(s)'s ID with you, or if someone else is picking up the kitten(s) they need to provide the kitty's ID at time of pick up.
- At that time you will receive the kitten(s)'s medical information & microchip registration form AND adoption fee is waived!!

Kittens under the age of 6 months are **not** required to be fasted the night before their appointment but please give the kitty **only a small snack 2 hours before drop off.**

For the Drop-off location, please refer to the picture below; the Clinic is the 2nd door with the sign "Clinic" above the door (partially hidden in the photo). In this photo there is a car parked in front of the Clinic entrance. The 1st set of double doors leads into the Lobby which will be closed when you drop off for your spay/neuter appointment.
